I am told that this initiative is just the beginning of what might become a sponsorship undertaking for Christian students all over the Middle East. I am sure that Our Lord Jesus is with you in all that you undertake, ---- and with him on your side your success is truly guaranteed.

May God continue to bestow his blessing on you in your work surrounding this undertaking and may this project and the many future projects that you continue to develop, flourish equally as well.
