The Mount of Olives is a mountain ridge in east Jerusalem with three peaks running from north to south. The Mount of Olives is associated with Christian traditions from Biblical times until today.

The Mount of Olives is frequently mentioned in the New Testament as the route from Jerusalem to Bethany and the place where Jesus stood when he wept over Jerusalem. Jesus is said to have spent time on the Mount, teaching, prophesying to his disciples, returning after each day to rest, and also coming there on the night of his betrayal.

At the foot of the Mount of Olives lies the Garden of Gethsemane. The New Testament tells how Jesus and his friends sang together.
“When they had sung the hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives” Gospel of Mathew.

Jesus ascended to heaven from the Mount of Olives. Land marks on the Mount of Olives include the Church of All Nations, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of Maria Magdalena, Dominus Flevit Church, the Church of Pater Noster, and Mary's Tomb.

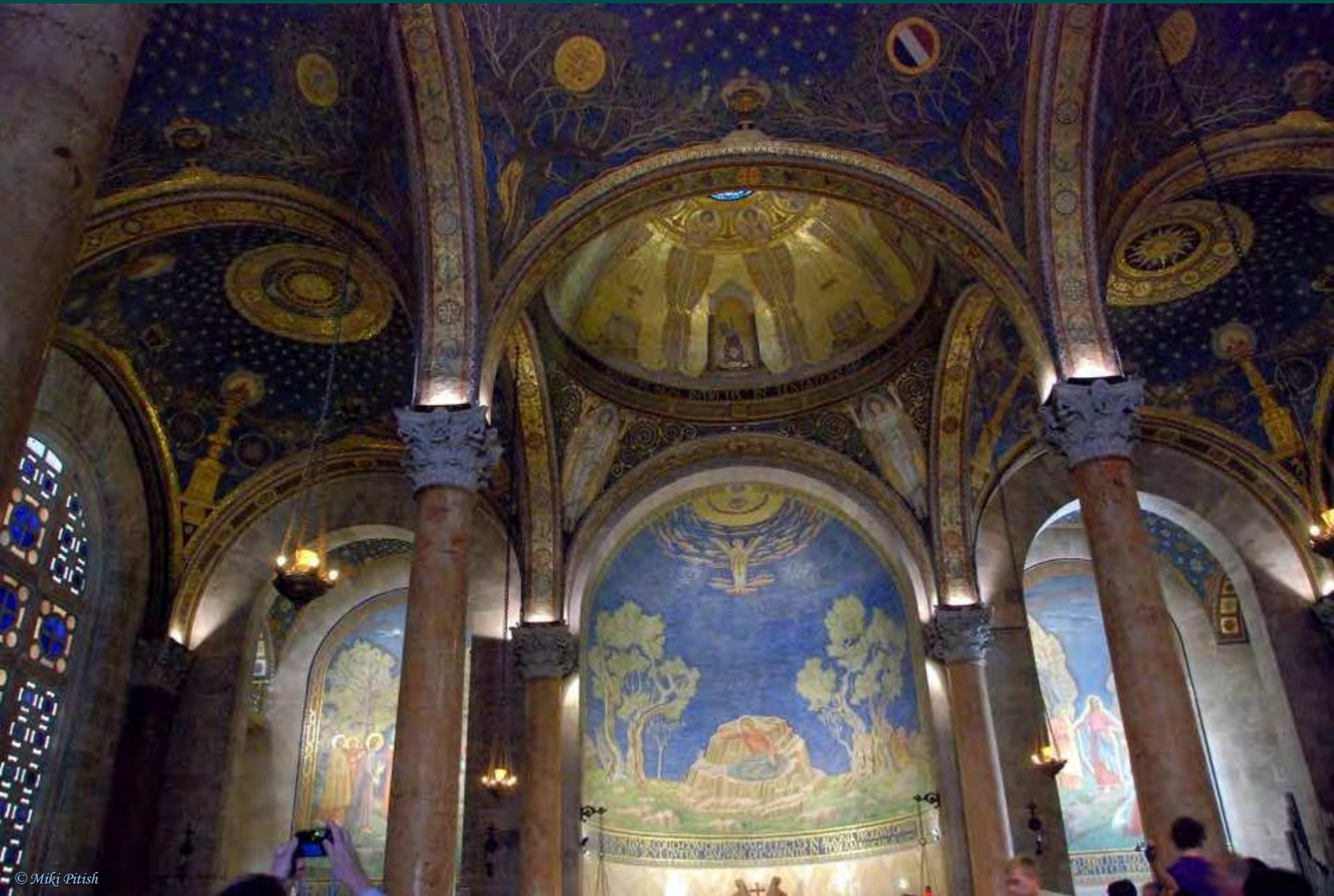

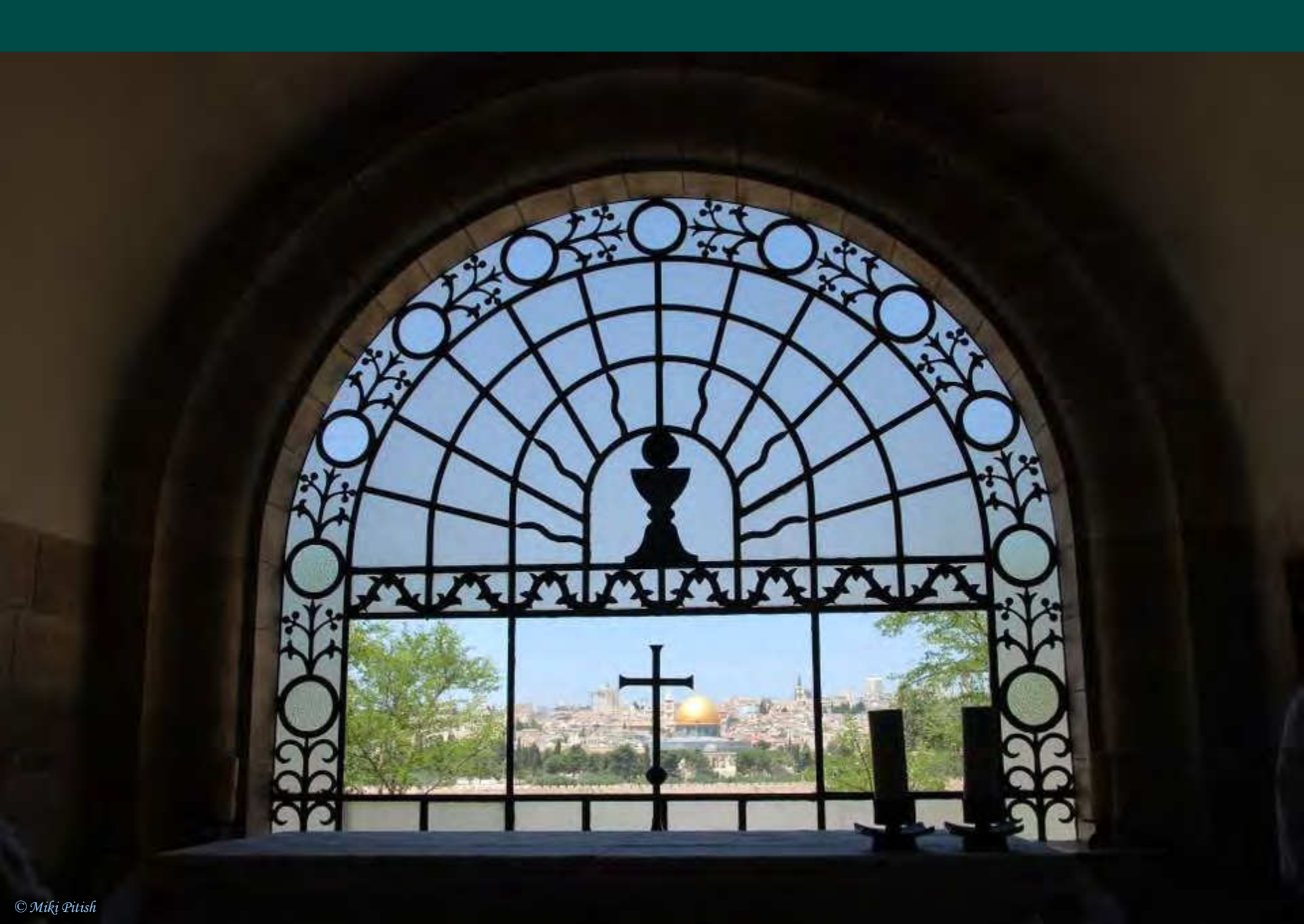
